Software Pre-requisites

Create™ will check for installed pre-requisites and if present, the software will install automatically and you will not need Administrator privileges.

You will be prompted to download and install any that are not present on the machine. Please note users may need Administrator privileges to install these pre-requisites if they are not present on the PC or Laptop.

Microsoft .Net 4 Client Profile must be installed before Microsoft Visual Studio 2010 Tools for Office Runtime, so please ensure that you install them in the following order:

- Microsoft .Net 4 Client Profile
- Microsoft Visual Studio 2010 Tools for Office Runtime

For the initial installation of Create you will need an internet connection to download and register the product.

Create™ will automatically check for Updates every 14 days. You will need to connect to the internet periodically to validate the license and download updates to the software, help guides and customisations.

Operating system

Create™ is supported for both 32-bit and 64-bit client applications and will run on the following operating systems:

- Windows XP
- Windows Vista
- Windows 7

Hardware

Ensure your computer meets the minimum requirements for the installed version of Office.
